

# Guidelines & Requirements Medicine, Engineering and Science


### **Nomination Guidelines**

- Nomination Categories: Only one category may be designated
- **Re-nomination**: Nominees automatically renominated for two years after first nomination
- Research Teams: Teams may be nominated in any category
- Nominator Requirements: TAMEST members, university presidents, chancellors, provosts, vice presidents for research, deans, industry executives as well as past recipients of the award

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Nominees must:
  - Be within 15 years of their first faculty appointment
  - Have spent the past two years performing research in Texas
- All team members must meet award eligibility requirements
- TAMEST members are not eligible

# **Guidelines & Requirements** Technology Innovation

### **Nomination Guidelines**

- **Re-nomination**: Nominees automatically renominated for two years after first nomination
- Research Teams: Teams may be nominated.
   There must be one individual who functions as the driving force or leader
- Nominator Requirements: TAMEST members, university presidents, chancellors, provosts, vice presidents for research, deans, industry executives as well as past recipients of the award

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Nominees must:
  - Be within 25 years of their first full-time industry affiliated position
  - Have been continually employed in the state of Texas for the past two years
  - Have their technology successfully commercialized
- TAMEST members are not eligible

### O'Donnell Awards Informational Session Awards Timeline

February	Call for nominations open
April 30th	Deadline to submit nominations
May - June	Subcommittees review nominations
June	Top nominees are selected to be reviewed by external reviewers Site visits are made to industry organizations
July	Full committee meets to make final recommendations
August	Finalists submitted to Nobel Laureate committee for approval
September	Finalists submitted to TAMEST Board of Directors for final approval
October	Awards recipients are notified
